A seven-core optical cable is a multi-core fiber (MCF) cable containing seven independent cores within a single cladding, enabling high-capacity, simultaneous data transmission and advanced sensing capabilities.

Structure and Function A seven-core optical cable consists of seven separate optical cores embedded within a single fiber cladding. These systems can increase transmission capacity up to seven times compared to conventional single-core cables.
- Environmental Sensing:** Some seven-core cables integrate real-time sensing capabilities, detecting environmental impacts such as vibration, temperature changes, or mechanical strain, which is valuable for infrastructure monitoring and smart city applications.
- Underwater and Industrial Applications:** Specialized seven-core cables combine optical fibers with power lines for ROV (remotely operated vehicle) tethers and subsea operations, providing robust, waterproof, and zero-buoyancy solutions for underwater robotics, industrial automation, and offshore energy systems.
