This ribbon-based arrangement maximizes fiber density while minimizing cable diameter, making it suitable for high-capacity backbone networks.

Variants and Features

- Gel-free or dry-core:** Many 720-core cables are gel-free, reducing mess and simplifying handling.
- Armored options:** Some cables include interlocking armor or steel wire strength members for additional mechanical protection, especially in outdoor or direct-buried installations.
- Water-blocking:** Water-blocking tapes and dry cores prevent moisture ingress, enhancing reliability in harsh environments.
- Jacket materials:** PE or LSZH jackets are used depending on indoor or outdoor deployment, with color-coded jackets for easy identification.
