Access switches are network edge devices that connect end-user devices to the broader network, providing high port density, PoE, and essential data forwarding services.

OverviewAn access switch is a network device positioned at the access layer of a hierarchical network, directly connecting end-user devices such as computers, IP phones, wireless access points, cameras, printers, and IoT devices to the network infrastructure . It serves as the first point of contact for most endpoints, handling traffic forwarding, VLAN placement, and sometimes Power over Ethernet (PoE) to power connected devices .

- Power over Ethernet (PoE):** Many access switches can supply power to devices like IP phones, wireless access points, and security cameras, simplifying deployment .
- Security Features:** Built-in mechanisms such as 802.1X authentication, MAC address filtering, and port security help protect the network at the edge .
- Management and Configuration:** Access switches can be managed via web interfaces or command-line interfaces (CLI), supporting VLANs, QoS, and other network policies .
