- Electrical surges:** Voltage spikes from a failing alternator, battery, or wiring can permanently damage the module.
- Faulty actuators or stepper motors:** Sometimes the module is functional, but the motor controlling beam movement fails.

- Scan for fault codes:** Use a diagnostic tool to read module-specific codes, LIN bus errors, or stepper motor faults.
- Visual inspection:** Check headlamp connectors for corrosion, bent pins, moisture, or damaged wiring.
