An aggregation switch is a network device that consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or other edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers. By bundling multiple network connections into a single high-bandwidth link, aggregation switches help. The aggregation layer serves as the convergence point for multiple access layer switches and is responsible for handling all. Aggregation Switch refers to a device used to aggregate multiple low-speed links in a network and connect them to a higher-speed core network or upper-layer switch. It contains three layers: core, distribution, and access.
