- Main Distribution Boards (MDBs):** Centralized boxes distributing power to multiple circuits, often including circuit breakers, fuses, and metering devices.
- Sub-Distribution Boards (SDBs):** Smaller boxes branching from the main board to serve specific areas or equipment.
- DIN Rail Boxes:** Modular boxes using DIN rail-mounted components, common in Albania for residential and commercial installations, often supplied by distributors like Albaelettrica.
