Pigtails provide: Factory-grade connector quality Flexibility to splice into any cable system Time and labor savings Consistent long-term performance For singlemode fiber, which is sensitive to alignment and polishing, pigtails are almost always used because field termination rarely achieves the same low-loss and low-reflectance results. Termination Methods Pigtails are typically joined to the main fiber using fusion splicing, which permanently fuses the fibers together with minimal loss. Mechanical splicing is an alternative but is generally used for temporary connections or multimode fibers. M...
