- Environmental Conditions:** Outdoor, underground, or aerial installations may require additional preparation, protective enclosures, or weatherproofing.
- Equipment and Tools:** Fusion splicers, cleavers, and protective sleeves are essential; specialized tools for micro-armored cables can speed up the process.
- Project Scale:** Large-scale deployments benefit from pre-planned splice points and pre-terminated assemblies to optimize labor efficiency.
