Surface treatments like anti-rust coatings or powder painting enhance durability.

Component Installation Inside the enclosure, essential components are installed: Main and branch circuit breakers for power control and protection Busbars to distribute electricity to breakers Neutral and ground bars for safe wiring connections Terminals for incoming and outgoing cables Components are mounted according to the design layout, ensuring proper spacing, secure fastening, and accessibility for maintenance.

Wiring and Integration Wiring is performed following best practices to maintain electrical safety and minimize interference. Cables are routed neatly, connections are tightened, and insulation is verified. In complex assemblies, printed circuit boards, relays, and control devices may also be integrated, forming a complete box build assembly ready for system integration.

Testing and Quality Control Each assembled distribution box undergoes rigorous testing: Electrical performance tests, including current carrying capacity and insulation resistance High-voltage and leakage current...
