5. **Custom and Specialty Bundles:** Manufacturers can configure bundles in spot, line, grid, hex, or other custom shapes, with precise fiber counts, diameters, numerical apertures, and end terminations. These are used in laser delivery, instrumentation, and complex optical systems.

Fiber Characteristics

- Multimode vs. Single-mode:** Multimode fibers are common in bundles for higher light collection efficiency, while single-mode fibers are used for precise signal transmission.
- Numerical Aperture (NA):** Determines the light-gathering ability and acceptance angle of the fiber.
- Cladding:** Surrounds the core to confine light and reduce leakage.
- Wavelength Range:** Bundles can be designed for UV, visible, NIR, or mid-IR applications depending on fiber material.
