- Alignment:** Place fibers in a fusion splicer, which aligns the cores automatically or manually to ensure optimal light transmission.
- Fusion:** Apply heat via an electric arc or alternative methods like CO<sub>2</sub> lasers to melt and fuse the fiber ends together.
- Protection:** Cover the splice with a protective sleeve to maintain mechanical strength and environmental resistance.
- Testing:** Verify splice quality using optical time-domain reflectometry (OTDR) to ensure low-loss performance.

- Low signal loss:** Typically as low as 0.02 dB for single-mode fibers.
- High reliability:** Permanent splices are stronger and more durable than mechanical splices.
