

Busline Trapezoidal Cable Tray Support Installation

- Secure the tray: Close the tabs or use hold-down clamps to lock the cable tray to the trapeze support. Tighten all nuts and washers to ensure stability.
- Final adjustment: Verify that the tray is level and properly aligned. Ensure all hardware is tightened and the system can support the intended load.
