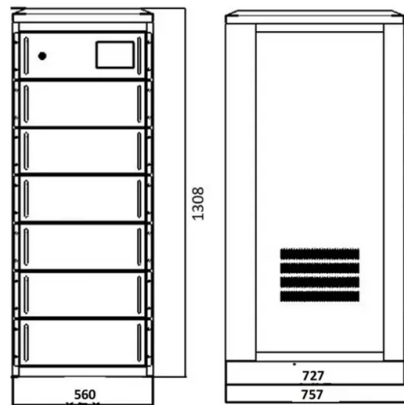


Cable and Cable Tray Installation Steps

Mounting and Support Secure trays using brackets, clamps, or hangers, spaced typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load. Ensure trays are level, straight, and properly connected. For long runs, use rollers to prevent cable kinks and damage during installation. Cable Laying Verify cable type and rating for open-air tray use (e.g., TC or MC cables) and check for compliance with NEC standards. Calculate maximum fill: Power cables should not exceed 40% of tray cross-section; control cables, 50%. Organize cables by voltage and function, using cable ties or straps, leaving slack for expansion or future adjustments. Maintain separation between high-power and low-power cables to prevent electromagnetic interference. Avoid excessive bending and sharp turns to prevent insulation damage. Grounding and Bonding Metallic trays must be properly grounded and bonded to maintain electrical continuity and safety. Use bonding jumpers across tray sections and ensure compliance with NEC Article 392. Final Checks Ensure clearances for maintenance (minimum 12 inches above trays) and accessibility.
