Maintain proper spacing and separation to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI) and allow heat dissipation. Use cable ties or straps at regular intervals (2-10 meters depending on layout) without over-tightening to avoid damaging insulation. For vertical or angled runs, secure cables to tray rungs or transverse members. **Tray Fill and Cable Capacity** Calculate tray fill to avoid overheating and maintain airflow. NEC Article 392 specifies maximum fill limits: typically 40% for power cables and 50% for control or signal cables. Overfilling can reduce ampacity and compromise safety. Consider future expansion by leaving additional capacity. **Grounding and Bonding** Metallic trays must be electrically continuous and bonded at all joints. Use bonding jumpers if mechanical connections do not provide reliable continuity. Connect the tray system to the building's main e...
