**Support Systems:** Proper support is essential to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity. Supports can be trapeze hangers for ceilings or cantilever wall mounts, spaced typically 1.2–3 meters apart depending on load and tray type. Expansion joints should be installed to accommodate thermal expansion.

**Installation Steps:**

- Pre-Installation Planning:** Review shop drawings, BOQ, and site layout. Ensure clearance, load capacity, and cable separation are considered.
- Marking and Support Fixing:** Use laser levels to trace straight routes. Install hangers and supports according to manufacturer specifications.
