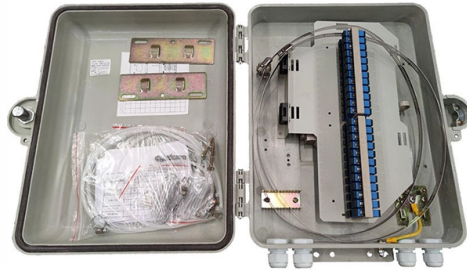


Cable tray requirements for hydrogen-related sites

Cable tray systems must comply with article 318 with respect to ampacity, grounding, fill, spacing and segregation of cable types. Cables must comply with their respective NEC articles and should be listed but in Division 2 locations it is not necessary that they be listed for.
