Constructed from welded steel wires forming an open mesh. Lightweight, flexible, and easy to install. Common in data centers and telecommunication facilities for low-voltage and fiber optic cables. Excellent for short-span applications and frequent cable changes.
- 5. Channel Cable Tray**
U-shaped or channel-like structure. Compact and cost-effective for light cable loads. Often used in tight spaces or short cable runs.

Material Options

Metallic: Steel, stainless steel, galvanized iron, aluminum. Aluminum is lightweight and corrosion-resistant; stainless steel is ideal for high-humidity or coastal areas; steel provides good electrical shielding.

Non-Metallic: Fiberglass reinforced plastic (FRP), which is lightweight, non-conductive, and corrosion-resistant, suitable for chemical plants or corrosive environments.
