Using a 600 mm centerline radius for the tray elbow would meet this requirement. Tools like cable tray bend calculators can help determine centerline arc lengths, setback distances, and offset dimensions to ensure compliance with NEC, IEC, and NEMA standards.

Offsets and Installation

Considerations In real-world installations, cable trays often need to bypass obstacles such as columns, pipes, or HVAC ducts. This is achieved using offsets, which typically involve two bends: one to move laterally and one to return to the original path. The horizontal run and sloped section length can be calculated using multipliers based on the bend angle, ensuring accurate cut marks and proper alignment. Pre-fabricated 45° or 90° offset fittings are recommended for standard dimensions, while field-bending is used for custom angles. Practical Tips Spacing of supports: Ensure supports are placed according to tray load and span requirements to prevent sagging. Field modifications: Round saws with non-ferrous blades can be used for cutting trays, and protective gear should be worn. Planning: Pre-plan the cable route to minimize the...
