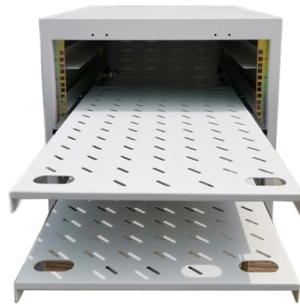


Campus Network Access Layer Switch



AI Overview

A campus network access layer switch connects end devices to the network, providing Layer 2 services, PoE support, and uplinks to distribution or core layers. Role of Access Layer Switches Access layer switches are the first point of connectivity for end devices such as computers, IP phones, wireless access points, and cameras within a campus LAN . They operate primarily at Layer 2, handling traffic within VLANs, and may provide Layer 3 capabilities like inter-VLAN routing in some models . These switches aggregate traffic from endpoints and forward it to the distribution layer, which then connects to the core layer for high-speed backbone transport . Key Features to Consider When selecting an access layer switch, several factors are critical: Port Density and Speed: Ensure sufficient ports for current and future devices, with support for 1G, 10G, or multi-gigabit speeds depending on traffic demands . Power over Ethernet (PoE): Required for devices like IP phones, cameras, and wireless access points . Uplink Options: Redundant uplinks to distribution switches improve fault tolerance and bandwidth . Scalability: Ability to stack switches or expand port capacity to accommodate growth . Security and Management: Support for 802.1X authentication, VLAN segmentation, and network monitoring simplifies administration and enhances security . Redundancy and Reliability: Features like MC-LAG, VSX, or stacking provide high availability and minimize downtime . Deployment Considerations Access switches are typically deployed in wiring closets across campus buildings. In a two-tier or three-tier hierarchical network, access switches connect to distribution switches, which aggregate traffic and provide routing, policy enforcement, and fault isolation . For small campuses, a collapsed core design may combine distribution and core functions, while larger campuses benefit from dedicated core switches to handle high-speed inter-building traffic .
