

Can an ADSL router be used as a fiber optic router

- Built-in Modem or Fiber-Compatible ONT:** Some routers include an integrated optical interface, allowing direct connection to fiber without a separate ONT.

How Fiber Internet Connects

Fiber Signal Conversion: The fiber line enters your home and connects to an ONT.

Data Transmission: The ONT converts light signals into electronic data and sends it to the router via Ethernet.

Routing: The router distributes the internet to devices via wired Ethernet or Wi-Fi.
