

Checking the single dual mode of optical modules on the switch

Methods to Identify Optical Module Mode

- Physical Inspection of the SFP Module**
 - Color Coding:** Single-mode SFPs often have blue or yellow pull tabs, while multimode SFPs typically have black pull tabs.
 - Wavelength Markings:** Single-mode modules usually operate at 1310nm or 1550nm, whereas multimode modules operate at 850nm.

- Check the Fiber Cable**
 - Single-mode fiber is usually yellow and has a thin core for long-distance transmission.
 - Multimode fiber is typically orange (OM2) or aqua (OM3) and supports shorter distances.
- Using Switch CLI Commands**
 - On Cisco switches, commands like `show interface status` or `show interface` can display the transceiver type and link status.
 - Some SFPs have type codes: LH indicates single-mode, SX indicates multimode, LX may support either, depending on the module.
 - For detailed optical information, commands like `show fiber-ports optical-transceiver` (Cisco) or `display transceiver` (Huawei) provide wavelength, power, and module type.
- Datasheet or Product Page**
 - If the module is unmarked or older, check the manufacturer's datasheet for specifications such as mode, wavelength, and supported fiber type.

Practical Tips

- Using the wrong fiber type can work for short distances but may cause signal loss or instability over longer runs.
- For third-party SFPs, ensure compatibility with the switch to avoid errors or reduced performance.
- Twinax or DAC cables are copper-based and not fiber; they are neither single-mode nor multimode.
- By combining physical inspection, CLI commands, and datasheet verification, you can reliably determine the mode of an optical module.
