Securing and Bonding Once the bases and supports are in place, cable trays are mounted and fastened using bolts, nuts, and other approved fasteners. All trays must be bonded to the main earthing system to ensure electrical continuity. Firestop systems and color coding may be applied to maintain safety and organization.
