

Classification Standards for the Sale of Communication Optical Cables

Communication optical cables in the EU must comply with the Construction Products Regulation (CPR), be CE marked, and classified according to Euroclasses based on fire performance. Regulatory Framework In the European Union, the Construction Products Regulation (CPR, EU/305/2011) governs the sale of communication cables, including fiber optic cables permanently installed in buildings. The CPR ensures that all construction products meet health, safety, and performance requirements and allows for consistent trade across EU member states. CE marking is mandatory for all cables covered by CPR, indicating compliance with the regulation and the cable's reaction to fire performance. Classification of Fire Performance Cables are classified into Euroclasses based on their reaction to fire, with A representing the highest performance and Fca the lowest. The classification considers multiple parameters, including: Flame spread (FR) Total heat release (THR) Heat release rate (HRR) Fire growth rate (FIGRA) Total smoke produced (TSP) Smoke production rate (SPR) Droplets of flaming material The main test standards used for classification include EN 50399, EN 60332-1-2, and EN ISO 1716. Euroclass Eca represents the minimum requirement, meeting EN 60332-1-2 standards. Testing and Certification Testing must be conducted by an authorized laboratory or notified body, which issues a Declaration of Conformity. This allows manufacturers to apply the CE mark to the cable or its packaging. The EN 50575 standard defines the procedures for testing and classifying cables, including extended application rules (EXAP) that allow test results from one cable construction to be applied to similar cables, reducing the need for repeated testing. Scope and Exemptions The CPR applies only to permanently installed power and communication cables. Patch cords, work area cords, and cable...
