

Cold aisle dimensions for server racks in intelligent computing centers

According to the ANSI/TIA/EIA-942-A standard, the recommended width for a cold aisle is 1,2 meters, which typically corresponds to the size of two double floor tiles. Cold air is supplied via perforated tiles at the front of the cabinets, which is distributed to cabinet by fans.
