- ST (Straight Tip): Round bayonet type, often used in legacy wiring systems ().

Threaded flanges, such as SM05, SM1, or C-Mount, allow precise alignment and coupling with optical components, lenses, or fiber couplers ().

Materials and Construction

High-quality flanges are typically made from 304 stainless steel, which is precision-machined, demagnetized, and treated with plasma cleaning and sandblasting to enhance corrosion resistance, durability, and non-reflective surfaces (). This ensures stable performance and minimal interference from ambient light.
