

Configuration Requirements for Distribution Boxes and Switch Boxes

- Surge Protective Devices (SPDs):** Protect against voltage spikes and lightning surges.
- DIN Rails:** Mounting rails for modular devices like MCBs and RCDs.
- Meters and Instruments:** Voltmeters, ammeters, and energy meters for monitoring load and system performance.

Material and Construction Standards

Enclosure Material: Cold-rolled steel plates (1.5–2.0 mm for distribution boxes, 1.2 mm for switch boxes) or flame-retardant insulating materials.

Surface Treatment: Anti-corrosion coating, rainproof and dustproof for outdoor use.

Compliance: Must meet national standards (e.g., CCC certification in China) and international standards such as IEC 61439, IEC 60670, IEC 60898, UL/NEC, or BS 7671.

Power Distribution Levels: “Three-level power distribution, two-level leakage protection, one machine one switch, one leakage one box” is recommended for construction sites.

Spacing: Distribution boxes should be within 30 meters of swi...
