Both local and remote interfaces must have compatible optical modules installed, and after configuration, the switch must save the settings and restart the interface for changes to take effect . Straight-Through Optical Connections A straight-through optical connection typically means direct mapping of input to output ports without crossing signals. Unlike copper Ethernet, where TX and RX pairs may need crossover or auto-MDIX, optical straight-through connections rely on matching transmit (TX) and receive (RX) fibers between devices. Ensure that the TX of the switch port connects to the RX of the remote device and vice versa. For multi-channel switches, the port mapping can be controlled via the switch GUI or command-line interface to select the desired output fiber .
