

Connect fiber optic patch cord to optical interface

- Verify the Connection** Check the device for link lights or use an optical power meter to ensure proper signal transmission. Confirm that the fiber is not under tension and that the routing allows for future maintenance.

Best Practices

- Always clean connectors before insertion to prevent signal loss.
- Use color-coded patch cords to distinguish single-mode (yellow) from multimode (orange, aqua, or lime green).
- Avoid sharp bends, kinks, or excessive pulling.
- Route fibers in ODF cabinets or trays to protect them from mechanical stress.
- Match the fiber type and connector to the device specifications to ensure optimal p...
