Verify Port Support: Some SFP+ ports on 10G switches accept 1G SFP modules, but SFP ports on Gigabit switches generally cannot support 10G modules. Interface Matching: Confirm the optical interface type (LC, SC, etc.) and fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) match between the module and port. Testing Connectivity: After installation, test the link to ensure proper operation at the reduced speed. Avoid Forceful Insertion: Insert modules gently to prevent damage to the port or module. Recommendation For optimal network performance, it is best to match the optical module speed to the port speed. Using a 10G module on a 1G port is only a temporary solution if the module supports dual-rate operation. Otherwise, consider replacing the Gigabit port or using a 1G SFP module to ensure stable and efficient n...
