7. Enclosure: The outer casing, made from durable materials like polycarbonate, ASA, or epoxy-coated stainless steel, protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage.
8. Electrical Wiring: Includes the internal wiring connecting the main supply, busbars, and circuit breakers, often protected by MCBs or fuses.
9. Optional Components: Modern distribution boxes may include surge protective devices, indication lights, and smart modules for energy monitoring and remote control.
