For long spans, continuous or intermittent support may be used depending on the tray type and load. Splice plates and fittings are used to connect tray sections, change direction, or adjust height and width. Proper alignment and secure fastening are essential to maintain structural integrity and electrical safety. Cables can enter or exit from the top or bottom of the tray, and tie-down points on rungs help maintain cable positions in horizontal or vertical runs.
