Role of Memory in Core Switches Memory in a core switch serves several critical functions:

- Packet Buffers:** Memory temporarily stores incoming and outgoing packets to handle bursts of traffic and prevent packet loss during congestion. Large buffers are essential in data centers and high-bandwidth environments.
- Routing Tables and ARP Tables:** Memory holds Layer 3 routing information, VLAN tables, and MAC address tables, enabling the switch to make fast forwarding decisions.
- Control Plane Operations:** Memory supports the switch's operating system, routing protocols, and management functions, ensuring smooth operation and redundancy.
- Performance Monitoring:** Core switches track CPU and memory utilization to detect bottlenecks, optimize throughput, and maintain low latency. High-end core switches often use Application-Specific Integrated Circuits (ASICs) to accelerate packet forwarding, with memory tightly integrated to support wire-speed performance. Redundant memory and hot-swappable modules are common in enterprise-grade switches to ensure continuous operation even during component failures.
