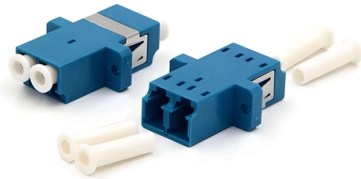

Cable Management: Ensure trays allow for the minimum permissible bend radius of the largest cable. Organize cables neatly to prevent sagging or overheating.

Grounding and Bonding: Install earth continuity strips at all joints and connect a separate grounding cable to the earth bar to ensure electrical safety.
