Multiply the total square footage by 3 VA per square foot per NEC Table 220. For a 2,000 sq ft home, this equals 6,000 VA. This covers all general-use receptacles and lighting outlets. Add 1,500 VA for each small appliance circuit (minimum two required) and 1,500 VA for the laundry.
