Apply Notification Policies Link the threshold to alarm notifications so that operators are alerted when the current exceeds the defined limits. This can include visual indicators, audible alarms, or automated alerts to a centralized monitoring system ().

Enable and Test the Threshold After setting the values, enable the threshold rule. Monitor the system to ensure alarms trigger correctly without excessive false positives. Adjust thresholds if necessary based on observed load patterns and environmental factors ().
