

Denmark Installation of 2-core ADSS Optical Cable

Installation Methods

Stationary Reel Method: Place the cable reel at one end of the span and a take-up reel at the other. Thread a pull line through cable travelers and attach the ADSS cable using a woven wire pulling eye. Pull the cable under controlled tension, ensuring the minimum bending radius is not exceeded.

Moving Reel Method: Generally not recommended for ADSS cables due to uneven tension on hardware.

Sag and Tension Management Calculate sag and tension based on span length, cable weight, and environmental conditions using sag/tension tables or manufacturer guidelines. ADSS cables have low thermal expansion, so temperature effects on sag are minimal, but wind and ice loading must be considered. Maintain proper separation from power lines and other utilities according to local Danish reg...
