Vertical Elbows (Risers): Change the elevation of the tray, either ascending or descending. Height is critical to maintain cable bend radius. Adjustable or Multi-Angle Elbows: Some manufacturers provide elbows that can be adjusted between 30° and 90° to accommodate complex routing. These still conform to the width and height of the connected tray sections . Material and Finish Considerations Elbows are made from the same material as the straight tray sections, such as steel (galvanized or powder-coated), aluminum, or stainless steel, to ensure structural integrity and corrosion resistance .
