Twenty-three inches (584 mm) between a stepped aisle handrail or guard and seating where the stepped aisle is subdivided by a mid- aisle handrail. Forty-two inches (1067 mm) for level or ramped

A minimum width of 1600mm should be provided between handrails, and the maximum width between handrails should not exceed 4000mm (an additional central handrail should be provided to stairs
