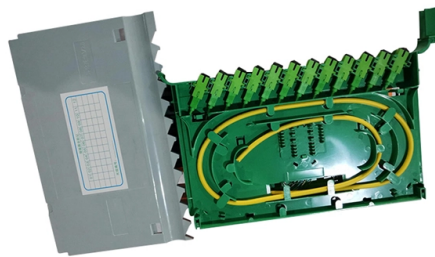


Dimensions of the guardrail for fixed distribution boxes

OSHA-Compliant Dimensions

Additional Considerations

- Post Spacing:** Posts should be spaced to maintain stability, typically not exceeding 6 feet apart for pedestrian guardrails.
- Width and Clearance:** While the width of the guardrail can vary depending on installation, a minimum thickness of 2 inches by 4 inches for rails and posts is recommended.
- Pedestrian Guardrails:** Standard pedestrian guardrails are usually 1 to 1.1 meters (approximately 39–43 inches) in height and 2 meters long, suitable for protecting personnel around equipment.

Practical Implementation

When installing a guardrail around a distribution box:

- Ensure the top rail is at 42 inches from the floor or platform surface.
- Install a midrail halfway between the top rail and the surface.
- Use sturdy materials such as steel or reinforced polymer to resist impact.
- Maintain post spacing within recommended limits to prevent sagging or failure.
- Verify that openings between rails do not exceed 19 inches to prevent accid...
