Overview of Distribution Boxes A distribution box (DB box) is a central hub that routes electrical power from a main supply to various circuits within a building or facility, ensuring safe and organized power management. DB boxes house key components such as:

- Circuit breakers (MCB, MCCB) to protect circuits from overloads and short circuits
- Residual Current Circuit Breakers (RCCB) for enhanced safety against earth faults

- Neutral and grounding links to ensure proper current return and safety
- Isolators for safely disconnecting circuits during maintenance

Current Ratings in Distribution Boxes Current ratings are critical for safe operation and are defined under IEC 61439 standards. The key parameters include:

- I_nA (Assembly Rated Current):** The maximum current the main busbar can safely carry in the assembled DB box without exceeding temperature rise limits. It accounts for thermal interactions between components, not just the sum of individual breaker ratings.
- I_{nc} (Circuit Rated Current):** The maximum continuous current a specific circuit can carry within the assembly, considering heat dissipation and mounting density. I_{nc} may be lower than the device's nominal rating (I_n) due to thermal constraints.
- RDF (Rated Diversity Factor):** A thermal derating factor applied to account for simultaneous loading of multiple circuits, ensuring the assembly does not overheat. For example, a 400A m...
