Terminations and connectors: Conductors up to 16mm² should be twisted and clamped securely, while larger conductors use tunnel lugs or compression connectors. Insulating covers must be applied to prevent exposure of bare connections.

Safety and inspection: After wiring, a thorough safety inspection should be conducted to check for short circuits, overloads, and proper grounding. Torque values for screws and connectors should follow manufacturer specifications...
