Switch Connection A network switch is used to expand the number of wired connections in your network. It connects to the router via an Ethernet port, not directly to the fiber cable. Devices plugged into the switch can communicate with the router and access the internet, but the switch itself does not handle the fiber signal conversion . Summary Fiber cable → ONT → Router → Switch (optional) → Devices The ONT is mandatory for converting optical signals to electrical signals. The router handles network management and internet access. Switches are optional and only extend wired connectivity within the local network. This configuration ensures optimal performance, low latency, and full utilization of fiber internet speeds while maintaining proper network management and device connectivity .
