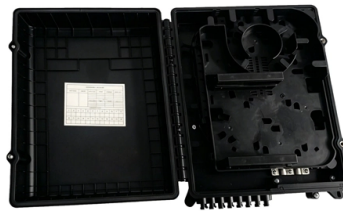

- IIIC:** Equipment suitable for conductive dust environments ().

Temperature Class

Defines the maximum surface temperature of the enclosure to prevent ignition of surrounding materials. Common classes include T6 (85°C) to T4 (135°C) for gases and T80°C to T130°C for dust ().

Zone Classification

- Zone 1 / Zone 2:** Areas with flammable gases or vapors; Zone 1 has a higher risk than Zone 2 ().
- Zone 21 / Zone 22:** Areas with combustible dust; Zone 21 has a higher risk than Zone 22 ().

Construction and Materials

Explosion-proof distribution boxes are typically made from stainless steel (304 or 316L) or high-strength GRP, with specialized hinges and flameproof joints to maintain integrity during operation (). They are designed for modular installation, allowing flexibility in complex distribution systems.
