These copper elements are used to deliver power to remote devices like wireless access points, IP cameras, or distributed antenna systems, while the optical fibers handle data transmission. This combination allows a single cable to provide both connectivity and electrical power. Summary Standard fiber optic cables: No copper in the core; data is transmitted via light.
