Connection Point: Allows joining of multiple fiber cables, often using splices or connectors. Installation: Typically installed close to the work area to minimize cable lengths and signal loss. Can be used for aerial or underground deployments. Components: May include splice trays, cable glands, and protective enclosures, but generally focuses on cable management rather than distribution to multiple endpoints. Applications: Intermediate network points, outdoor or indoor junctions, and areas where multiple fiber routes converge.
