For example, the Consumer Advice Centre in Germany sued Deutsche Glasfaser and Deutsche Giganetz over contracts allowing unilateral changes to transmission technology or imposing vague usage restrictions. Such disputes often involve consumer protection issues, aggressive sales tactics, or unclear terms regarding service obligations and contract duration.
