Always verify that fibers are dark using a fiber optic power meter before inspection or splicing. When working with live fibers, wear safety glasses with side shields that filter infrared light, and post warning signs in work areas to alert others. Avoid removing transceiver covers while devices are operational to prevent accidental exposure to laser radiation.

Handling and Physical Safety Fiber optic strands are extremely delicate and can cause physical injury if broken. Always handle fibers carefully to avoid glass splinters, and dispose of fiber scraps in sealed, labeled containers. Avoid bending cables sharply, as this can damage the fiber and degrade signal performance. Use powder-free gloves when handling connectors or optical surfaces to prevent contamination and protect your skin.

Chemical Safety Cleaning and adhesive chemicals used in fiber optic maintenance can be flammable and toxic. Work in well-ventilated areas, use small amounts of flammable solvents, and store them away from heat sources. Follow Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for each chemical, and avoid contact with eyes or skin. Flush immediately with water if contact occurs, and dispose of containers according to MSDS guidelines.

Preventive Maintenance Regular cleaning of fiber optic connectors and optical surfaces is essential to maintain signal integrity. Use clean dry air (CDA) to remove dust, and apply spectroscopic-grade methanol with lens tissue for stubborn contaminants. Inspect surfaces under high-intensity light or magnification, and always cover conn...
