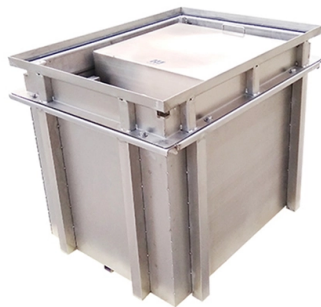

- 3. Aerial and Exposed Installations** For overhead cables, use aerial-rated cables with UV-resistant jackets and ensure proper tensioning to prevent sagging. In exposed environments like bridges or tunnels, mount cables in protective enclosures and maintain strain relief to prevent fiber pullout.
- 4. Weatherproofing and Enclosures** Use IP68-rated waterproof closures, gel-filled cables, and water-blocking tapes to prevent moisture ingress. Protect connectors and splices with sealed enclosures, dust caps, and gaskets to block contaminants.
- 5. Grounding and Electrical Protection** For metallic-armored cables, ground both ends to prevent voltage buildup. Use corrosion-resistant clamp...
