Protective sheathing should remain in place until installation, and cables should not be pulled over edges or subjected to twisting. Figure-8 loops are recommended when coiling cable to prevent torsion . Environmental and Safety Considerations: Ensure the shaft is free of sharp objects or debris that could damage the cable.
