Routing and Managing Fibers Ensure the fiber length inside the box allows the front panel to be fully extended without tension; a minimum of 31 inches is recommended for trunk cables. Use bending radius control clips and spools to prevent sharp bends and maintain fiber integrity. Secure fibers with cable ties, including movable ties for flexibility during maintenance.

Connect fibers to adapter panels, splice trays, or patch panels as required for the network configuration.

Testing and Maintenance After installation, test the connections using tools like optical time-domain reflectometers (OTDR) to ensure signal quality. Maintain organized cable management to simplify troubleshooting and future expansions.

Best Practices Avoid pulling, bending, or crushing fibers during installation.
